Coins of Hadrian (117-138).

This listing will showcase a selection of denarii of the emperor Hadrian. His reign was one of relative stability and peace, though not without its conflicts. Among his best known monuments to survive to modern times are the extensive wall in the north of England, Hadrian's wall; his rebuilding of the Temple of Zeus in Athens; and the wonderful Pantheon in Rome.

Note the wide variety of bust types as they progress and change over the period of his reign.



NS133. Rev: Trajan and Hadrian holding globe between them (*one of the adoption issues*). (3.03g) RIC Rome 2, SM.3509. SCARCE nVF \$295-00



NS134. Rev: Pax holding branch and cornucopiae. (3.06g) RIC Rome 7c, SM.-. VF \$235-00



NS135. Rev: Concordia seated left holding patera, cornucopiae below chair, statue of Spes below elbow. (3.11g) RIC Rome 9; SM.-. nVF \$235-00



NS136. Rev: Pietas standing left, raising right hand. (3.34g) RIC Rome 22, SM.-. VF+ \$275-00



NS137. Obv: Laureate bust of Hadrian, right, *aegis* on left shoulder. Rev: Salus seated left holding patera feeding snake coiled around altar. (3.12g) Not in RIC! cf. Rome 46, SM.-. *Unlisted with this bust!* VF \$395-00



NS138. Rev: Spes holding flower, raising dress. (3.01g) RIC Rome 100, SM.3526. VF, light scratches \$160-00



NS139. Rev: Libertas holding pileus and sceptre. (3.26g) RIC Rome 128, cf. SM.3503. nVF \$195-00



NS140. Rev: Star above and within crescent. (3.07g) RIC Rome 200, SM.3484. Scarce type, nVF \$250-00

NS141. Rev: Aequitas holding scales and sceptre. (3.54g) RIC Rome 228, SM.3457. nVF \$180-00



NS142. Rev: Modius with poppy and ears of wheat. (3.18g) RIC Rome 230, SM.3461. nVF \$235-00



NS143. Rev: Egypt reclining holding sistrum, resting arm on basket, ibis before. (3.26g) RIC Rome 297, SM.3456. F+ SCARCE \$195-00



NS144. Rev: Roma seated right on cuirass and shield holding spear and parazonium. (3.07g) RIC Rome 332, SM.-. VF \$235-00
