NS58. Marius 268 Antoninianus Rev: Victory advancing right with wreath and palm. (2.81g) RIC Mainz or Trier 17; SM.11123. nVF \$325-00



NS51. Augustus 27BC-AD14 Æ As Rev: Altar of Lugdunum. (10.78g) RIC Lugdunum 230; SM.1690. F+/VF \$395-00

NS53. Claudius 41-54 Æ Quadrans Obv: Hand holding scales. Rev: Legend around large SC. (3.85g) RIC Rome 85; SM.1864. EF \$120-00

NS54. Domitian – Antoninus Pius c.81-c.161 Æ Quadrans Obv: Draped bust of Mercury, right. Rev: Winged caduceus. (2.71g) SM.2927; RIC Rome 31 (p.219). nVF \$135-00

NS55. Commodus 177-192 Æ As Rev: Apollo Moneta leaning against column, hand on head, legs crossed. (9.83g) RIC Rome 569 R; SM.5854. RARE F+ \$175-00



NS56. Trajan Decius 249-251 Silver Antoninianus Rev: Dacia holding Draco-staff. (3.44g) RIC Rome 12b; SM.9368. Superb EF \$225-00

NS57. Salonina, wife of Gallienus, 253-268 Silver Antoninianus Rev: Venus, seen from behind, leaning on column, holding palm and apple. (3.49g) RIC Lugdunum 8; Göbl Cologne 904c. EF/VF \$115-00

NS59. Claudius II Gothicus 268-270 Antoninianus Rev: Providentia leaning on column, holding baton and cornucopiae, globe at feet. (4.23g) RIC Rome 91; SM.11363. EF/VF+ \$90-00

NS60. Severina, wife of Aurelian, 270-275 Silvered Antoninianus Rev: Concordia holding two standards. (3.47g) RIC Rome 4; SM.11705. VF+ \$135-00

NS61. Probus 276-282 Antoninianus Rev: Salus standing right, holding serpent which she feeds from her left hand. (3.83g) cf.SM.12031; cf.RIC Ticinum 567. VF+ \$100-00



NS62. Carausius 287-293 Antoninianus Rev: Providentia standing left, holding cornucopiae and baton, globe at feet. (4.30g) RIC Camulodunum 346. VF+ \$225-00

NS63. Diocletian 284-305 Silvered Antoninianus Rev: Diocletian receiving Victory holding wreath on globe from Jupiter. (3.58g) RIC Antioch 324. EF \$125-00



NS64. Constantine I 307-337 Follis Rev: Victory advancing right, holding trophy, captive before. (3.11g) RIC Trier 429. EF \$125-00

NS65. Divus Constantine after 337 Æ3 Rev: Constantine veiled, right. (1.61g) RIC Const. 68. F+ \$60-00

NS66. Valentinian II 375-392 Æ2 Obv: Helmeted, diademed and draped bust, right, holding spear and shield. Rev: Emperor on galley, left, Victory at helm. (5.55g) RIC Constantinople 52b.F+ \$75-00

NS67. Theodosius I 379-395 Æ4 Rev: Victory advancing left, carrying trophy and dragging captive. (1.32g) RIC Antioch 70a. F/VF \$50-00
