NS191. Sikyonia, Sikyon 365/45-335/0BC Æ13 or Chalkous Obv: Dove flying left. Rev: Large M (or Sigma, Σ) with palmette. (1.96g) BCD 273.1-2; SNG Cop.74. *Rare*, VF \$435-00

NS192. Megaris, Megara c.250-175BC Æ14 or Chalkous Obv: Prow of galley left Rev: Obelisk of Apollo Karinos flanked by dolphins. (2.34g) BCD 20; Kroll 645; SNG Copenhagen 477. *Scarce*, nF \$150-00



NS193. Antiochus IV 175-164BC Æ16 Obv: Diademed bust of Antiochus, right. Rev: Artemis drawing arrow from quiver, holding bow, monograms to either side. (4.11g) SC.1387 var. *Only six examples recorded in the SC, Unpublished with these monograms.* F+/VF \$275-00

NS194. Parthia, Phraates IV 38-2BC Æ11 Obv: Bust of Phraates left. Rev: Head of Tyche right. (1.59g) cf. Shore 556; cf. Sellwood 54.15. *Rare* nF \$80-00

NS195. Roman Republic, L. Thorius Balbus 105BC Silver Denarius Obv: Head of Juno Sospita. Rev: Bull charging right. (3.62g) SM.192; Thoria 1. nVF \$150-00

NS196. Roman Republic, L. Marcius Philippus 57BC Silver Denarius Obv: Head of Ancus Marcius, lituus behind. Rev: Equestrian statue on aqueduct, flower below. (3.74g) SM.382; Marcia 28. F+ \$150-00



NS197. Ionia, Smyrna, Caligula 37-41 Æ19 Obv: Laureate head of Caligula right. Rev: Draped bust of Agrippina facing bare head of Germanicus. (6.09g) Klose 29; RPC 2471; SNG v.Aul 2201; S.413. *A Rare issue showing Caligula and his parents.* F+ \$295-00

NS198. Dardanian mines issue, time of Trajan to Hadrian c.98-138 Æ Quadrans Obv: Head of Roma. Rev: Female standing left. (2.67g) RIC (Hadrian) 1016; SM.3710. G/VG \$75-00



NS199. Philip II 247-249 Silver Antoninianus, as Augustus Rev: Philip I and Philip II seated on curule chairs. (4.22g) S.9265; RIC Rome 230. nEF \$175-00



NS200. Carausius 287-293 Antonianus Rev: Pax standing left. (3.89g) RIC London 880. VF+ \$175-00

NS201. Diocletian 284-305 Æ Follis Rev: Genius holding patera and cornucopiae. (9.94g) RIC Ticinum 33a. VF \$70-00



NS202. Constantine I 307-337 Æ3 Obv: Helmeted bust right. Rev: Two Victories inscribing shield, altar decorated with diamond and five pellets. (2.92g) RIC 193, R3. *Rare issue*, nEF \$165-00

NS203. Fausta, wife of Constantine I, Augusta 324-326 Æ3 Rev: Fausta standing facing, holding two children. (2.80g) RIC Cyzicus 50. VG \$30-00

NS204. Delmatius, Caesar 335-337 Æ3 Rev: Two soldiers, standard between. (1.44g) RIC Antioch 90 R3. *Rare*, nVF \$85-00



NS205. Theodosius I 379-395 Æ2 Rev: Theodosius on galley left, Victory at helm. (5.31g) RIC Cyzicus 23. VF+ \$160-00
