Obv: Bust of Nike, right. **Rev:** Nude River-god (Aisaros?) crowning himself, holding sceptre, hound to left. (3.58g) S.514 var.; BMC 321, 15f. nVF/VF, scarce symbol. **\$320-00**



NS248. Latium, Rome, Anonymous c.230-226BC Æ Double-Litra
Obv: Head of young Hercules wearing lion's skin, club below. **Rev:** Pegasus flying right, club above. (5.27g) Craw. 27/3; SM.591. F+ **\$340-00**



NS243. Sparta, Achaian League, Lakadaimon c.85BC Silver Hemidrachm
Obv: Laureate head of Zeus right. **Rev:** AX monogram, caps of the Dioskouroi to either side, monograms above and below, all within wreath. (2.44g) BCD Peloponnesos 865.4; Benner 6; Clerk 319. Lovely tone, EF **\$785-00**



NS249. Antoninus Pius 138-161 Æ As
Rev: Two *ancilia* (shields), each with rounded projections above and below. (10.46g) RIC 736a; SM.4293. VF **\$400-00**

NS244. Macedonian Kingdom, Kassander 305-297BC Æ18
Obv: Head of Herakles. **Rev:** Horseman right. (4.53g) S.6753; SNG Alpha Bank 900f. VG-F **\$40-00**

NS245. - , Kassander, as regent 317-305 BC Æ17
Obv: Head of Herakles. **Rev:** Lion reclining right. (4.10g) S.6754; SNG Alpha Bank 876f. VG-F **\$40-00**



NS246. Ionia, Ephesus 390-320BC Silver Diobol
Obv: Bee within border of dots. **Rev:** Two stag's heads facing. (0.99g) S.4375; BMC 53; SNG Kayhan 208f.; SNG von Aulock 1835. F+ **\$145-00**



NS250. Macrianus 260-261 Silvered Antoninianus
Rev: Indulgentia seated left holding sceptre, star in field. (3.70g) RIC 8, Samosata mint; SM.10801. F+ **\$395-00**



NS251. Maximinus II 309-313 Æ Follis
Rev: Sol holding globe. (4.75g) RIC Ostia 88 "S". VF **\$130-00**

NS252. Constans 337-350 Æ Half-Centenionalis
Rev: Radiate Phoenix standing upon mound of rocks. (2.63g) RIC Lugdunum 90 "R". VF **\$135-00**

NS253. Valentinian I 364-375 Æ3
Rev: Valentinian holding labarum, dragging captive. (1.52g) cf. RIC Siscia 14a. **This combination of mintmarks and field symbols not recorded in RIC (p.143).* F **\$40-00**
